Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Birkenhead River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 21, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 8,325 cubic metres per year at a rate not to exceed 0.032 cubic metres per minute.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is from April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 21, District Lot 1544, Lillooet District, Plan KAP56537, Except Plan EPP24948 of which 1.82 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are a screened intake, pump, meter, pipes, tanks and irrigation sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the *Water Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream for the preservation of fish and other aquatic life.
- k) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Act*.

- l) The licensee shall retain daily flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the *Water Act*.
- m) The intake must be screened to prevent the entry of aquatic wildlife.



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
