Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Tachick Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 24th January, 1990.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 814,100 m³/year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is from the 1st of April to the 30th of September.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 34, South 1/2 of Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 Section 34, Northwest 1/4 of Section 27, North 1/2 of Section 28, except the Westernly 25 M, Fractional Southeast 1/4 & Block A of the Fractional Southwest 1/4 of Section 28; All Township 3 Range 4 Coast District of which 270 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe and sprinkler system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Licence 101697.

- k) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
