## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Regional District of the Central Okanagan is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Trepanier Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 12th April, 1907.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation - local authority.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 9,251 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st April to 30th September.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lots 1 to 8 inclusive, all of District Lot 911 Osoyoos Division Yale District Plan KAP56335, of which 1.01 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe, flow measuring device, pump station, and reservoir which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- k) The licensee shall retain flow records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Act.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence Number 103637.

- m) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
