Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Naver Creek, Terry Creek, and Pedley Creek.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 2, 1973.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (stockwatering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for stockwatering purposes is 8.8 cubic meters per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of the Fractional South 1/2 of District Lot 3175 lying East of Plan A219, the North 1/2 of District Lot 8540, the Fractional South 1/2 of District Lot 8540, the East 1/2 of District Lot 3176 except Plans A1238 and A218, the South East 1/4 of District Lot 3182 except Plan A218, and the North East 1/4 of District Lot 3182 except Plan A218, all of Cariboo District.
- h) The authorized works are screened intakes, diversion structures, pipes, pumps, and troughs, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) Works allow for the watering of stock outside the wetted perimeter of Terry Creek, Naver Creek, and Pedley Creek.

- k) This licensee has a Crown Lease (file 0210208) for grazing on the East 1/2 of District Lot 3176 except Plans A1238 and A218, South East 1/4 of District Lot 3182 except Plan A218, and the North East 1/4 of District Lot 3182 except Plan A218, all of Cariboo District. The Crown Lease (file 0210208) must be in good standing for this licence to remain valid.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C113244.
- m) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
