

Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Salmon River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is September 1, 2015.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 50,000 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to July 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the Fractional South East 1/4 of District Lot 683 Cariboo District and the North East 1/4 of District Lot 2511 Cariboo District, Except the West 66 feet and Except Parcel A (Plan 24685) of which 16 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, irrigation system, pump and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence does not authorize the diversion of water for irrigation when the water flow of the Salmon River falls below 30% of the Mean Annual Discharge or 8.66 cubic metres per second as measured at the Wateroffice of Canada, Real-Time Hydrometric Station; 08KC001 Salmon River near Prince George for the preservation of fish or for maintaining the health of aquatic ecosystems.
- k) The licensee shall record daily use of water by the hours of pumping to the satisfaction of the Water Manager under the *Water Sustainability Act*.

1) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
