

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Franks Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 21st May, 1997.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (residential).
- The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 27.05 liters per minute (5.95 gallons per minute).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Strata Lot L Section 7 Township 26 Range 7 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Strata Plan KAS254 Together with an Interest in the Common Property in Proportion to the Unit Entitlement of the Strata Lot as Shown on Form V.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, sump, pipe, and powerhouse (including turbine (i.e. pelton wheel), generator, and transmission line) which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of licence C112357.
- k) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to one dwelling on Strata Lot L Section 7 Township 26 Range 7 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Strata Plan KAS254 Together with an Interest in the Common Property in Proportion to the Unit Entitlement of the Strata Lot as Shown on Form V, as shown on the attached plan.
- The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.

m) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
