

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Spectacle Creek.
- b) The points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 8, 1968.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage (non-power) and waterworks.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and held in storage is 225,000 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity of stored water which may be diverted for waterworks purpose is 850 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted and held in storage is the whole year and the period of the year in which the stored water may be diverted and used for waterworks purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Block 176, Malahat District, except those parts in Plans 249RW, 518RW, 13486, 13743, 35492, 41475, 50295, 1065RW and VIP82580.
- h) The authorized works that make up the water distribution system are dam, saddle dams, rediversion intakes, control gate, tunnel, penstock, reservoir and pipes which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- The construction of the said works has been partially completed. The completion of the new works and the beneficial use of the water shall be made prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee may be required to install an instream flow release device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Act* at any time. Any instream flow release volumes are to be derived and based on further studies.
- k) The dams authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the *Water Act* and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- 1) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C131994 in part.
