## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use, and store water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Moss Brook and Trooper Brook, and storage is in dugouts on Moss Brook and Trooper Brook.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 13, 1992.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are industrial (stockwatering) and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted to fill each dugout for storage purposes is 3700.44 cubic meters per year, and the maximum quantity of water which may be used for industrial (stockwatering) purposes is 9.092 cubic meters per day (4.546 cubic meters per day from each source).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is South West 1/4 of Section 9, Township 19, Range 5, Coast District.
- h) The authorized works are two dugouts, screened intakes, pumps, pipes, and troughs, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) Works shall be constructed to allow for the watering of stock outside the wetted perimeter of the source.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C105861.

- 1) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.



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
