

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use, and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Stony Creek and storage is in a reservoir located on North Stony Creek.
- b) The point of diversion and storage site are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 25, 1988.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are irrigation and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be used to fill the reservoir is 197,360 cubic meters per year, and the maximum quantity of water which may used for irrigation purposes is 197,360 cubic meters per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted into storage is October 1 to June 15, and the stored water may be used for irrigation from April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Block A of Section 3, and Block A of Section 4, all of Township 4, Range 4, Coast District, of which 65 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are a weir, diversion structure, screened intake, reservoir, pump, pipe, and irrigation system, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C071143.

k) This licence is issued under the *Water Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

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
