Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Tulameen River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 25, 1952.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation: private.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation: private is 3087.3000 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 9 and Parcel A (KW33897) of District Lot 1297 within Similkameen Division Yale District Plan 4960.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump, and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The licensee shall submit to the Comptroller of Water Rights, Water Manager, or an Engineer a Beneficial Use Declaration and drawing prepared to the water licence application drawing standards showing the point of diversion, area, beneficial use, all associated works, and legal boundaries of the appurtenant land, on or before the 31 day of December 2018.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence F021042, in part.
