CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Michael Lake and storage is in an off-stream dugout.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 28, 2015.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage (non-power) and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be held in storage is 33,500 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity of stored water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 30,837 cubic metres per year, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be held in storage is the whole year, with diversion into storage from October 1 to March 31, and the period of the year during which the stored water may be used for irrigation purpose is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1, District Lots 26 and 105, Oyster District, Plan 30755 of which 10.1 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are intake, pump, pipe, dugout, berms, pumphouse and irrigation system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
