## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to store and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is an unnamed stream (PD187706) that is a tributary to Shelby Creek and storage is in a dugout.
- b) The storage site is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is October 5, 2015.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored for irrigation is 6,167 cubic meters per year (5 acre feet).
- f) The period of the year during which water may be stored and used for irrigation is March 1 to August 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the North East 1/4 of District Lot 3544 Cariboo District Except Plan 28181 of which 40 acres (16.2 hectares) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are a dugout, a portable pump, and a portable irrigation system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.

- k) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
