

Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Okanagan Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is September 28, 1994.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 92,511.00 cubic metres per year (75 acre feet per annum).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30th.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot A, District Lot 2537, Osoyoos Division Yale District, Plan KAP85241; and Lot 1, District Lot 2537, Osoyoos Division Yale District, Plan KAP83875, of which 10.1 hectares (25 acres) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe and sprinklers, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be constructed to operate within a lake elevation of 340.41 to 343.09 metres (1116.8 to 1125.3 feet), Geodetic Survey of Canada datum.
- k) The water intake must be no less than three (3) metres below the lowest water level of Okanagan Lake.
- 1) The licence holder shall install works to meter and record the rate of flow and quantity of

water diverted under this licence.

- m) This licence is issued under the Water Sustainability Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- n) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C130500.
