

Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the undertaking to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Middle Spring.
- b) The point of diversion and storage site are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is September 29, 2015.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is waterworks and storage (non-power).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for waterworks purposes is 22,800 cubic metres per year provided the maximum daily diversion does not exceed 125 cubic metres per day. The maximum quantity of water that may be stored in the balancing pond is 900 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted into storage is the whole year, and the period of the year during which the water may be used for waterworks purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the undertaking of the licensee as set out in Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1493/2015 and any substitution thereof or amendment thereto.
- h) The authorized works are pipe, balancing pond, weir and treatment system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of the Water Manager under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- k) The licensee shall retain flow records for inspection upon request by the Water Manager under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
