

## Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

## **CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE**

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Wright Brook.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 4th September, 2007.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 1,850 cubic metres (1.5 acre feet) per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to August 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is All that portion of the North West 1/4 of Section 8 which lies to the north of the north shore of Salmon Arm of Shuswap Lake; Township 21 Range 9 West of the 6th Meridian except Plans 14217 and 32732, and All that portion of the South 1/2 of the South West 1/4 of Section 17 described as follows: commencing at the south west corner of the said 1/4 section, thence northerly along the west boundary of the said 1/4 section to its intersection with the dividing line between the north 1/2 and south 1/2 of the said 1/4 section, thence easterly along the said dividing line to its intersection with the east boundary of the said 1/4 section, thence southerly along the said east boundary to its intersection with the north shore of Salmon Arm of Shuswap Lake thence south westerly following the sinuosities of the said north shore to its intersection with the south boundary of said 1/4 section, thence westerly along said south boundary to the place of commencement; Township 21 Range 9 West of the 6th Meridian except Plan 14217; Kamloops Division Yale District; of which 7.284 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are pipe, sprinklers, and flow measuring device, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.

- j) The licensee shall install a flow metering or other measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.
- k) The licensee shall retain flow meter/measurement records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.
- This licence is issued under the Water Sustainability Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
