## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store, and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Palmer Creek and storage is in dugout.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 21, 1924.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 2.0 cubic metres (440 gallons) per day, and for irrigation purpose is 1,233 cubic metres (1 acre foot) per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for domestic purpose is the whole year, and for irrigation purpose is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land on which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lots 11 and 12 of Section 20 Township 20 Range 10 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Plan 1413, of which 0.304 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are a pipe (Fully Constructed), pond (Fully Constructed), and water meter (Not Constructed) which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the outstanding works shall be completed prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued in substitution of F008319, in part
- k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- l) The licensee shall install a flow metering or other measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.
- m) The licensee shall retain flow meter/measurement records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.

- n) This licence is issued under the Water Sustainability Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
