CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The City of Campbell River is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Campbell River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is January 18, 1984.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is waterworks (local provider).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 6,028,115 cubic metres per year provided the maximum daily diversion does not exceed 49,552 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is all the lands within the boundaries of the City of Campbell River waterworks area.
- h) The authorized works are deep intake, pipe, and treatment facility which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C061333.
- k) This water licence has been issued subject to the Order in Council Water Reserve 1440/1940.
