## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert & use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Kitimat River.
- b) The point of diversion (PD35841) is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 10, 1967.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is processing (aluminum).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for processing (aluminum) purpose is 45,260.352 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is throughout the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is as described in the attached Schedule A and shown on the attached plan.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structures (screened intake), pumphouses, pumps, pipe, reservoir, tank, treatment facility and distribution system, which shall be located approximately as shown on Lapointe Engineering Ltd. Drawings No. 041-6066-C-001-004. The diversion structure, screened intake, pumphouse, pipe and distribution system are joint works with conditional water licence C133050.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction,

maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C132175.
