

## Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Trapping Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 20, 1962.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic and stockwatering (livestock & animal).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic is 2.273 cubic metres per day and the maximum quantity which may be used for stockwatering (livestock & animal) is 4.546 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for domestic and stockwatering (livestock & animal) is January 1 to December 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the South East 1/4 of District Lot 1509 Cariboo District, Except Plans 20411 and H616.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump, pipe and screened intake which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence Number 60856.
- k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling and in one building for stockwatering (livestock & animal) located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
