

Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Sakinaw Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 15, 2015.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for Domestic purpose is 1 cubic metre per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is January 1 to December 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 19, District Lot 3248, Plan 11997.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, tank and pump which are fully constructed, and which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be regulated at any time by an Order issued under the Water Sustainability Act to conserve or regulate water flow and availability in Sakinaw Lake or Sakinaw Creek for the preservation and benefit of aquatic life and/or supply/demand management amongst licensees. Regulation includes allowing, commencing, stopping, limiting, opening, shutting and prohibiting the diversion of water.
- k) The intake must be screened to prevent the entry of aquatic wildlife. For further guidance, refer to the Fisheries and Oceans "Freshwater Intake End-of-Pipe Fish Screen Guideline" at http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/Library/223669.pdf

- 1) This licence is issued under the Water Sustainability Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- m) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling, located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
