CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is/are Little Meadow Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 28, 2003.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Irrigation: Private.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for Irrigation: Private is 74008.8 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to July 15.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is THE WEST 1/2 DISTRICT LOT 961 RANGE 5 COAST DISTRICT EXCEPT PLANS 10669 AND EXCEPT THE MOST SOUTHERLY 25 METRES AND THE MOST WESTERLY 25 METRES THEREOF AND EXCEPT PLAN PRP14963.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, screened intake, pump, pipe, balancing reservoir and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C118705.

- k) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
