Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

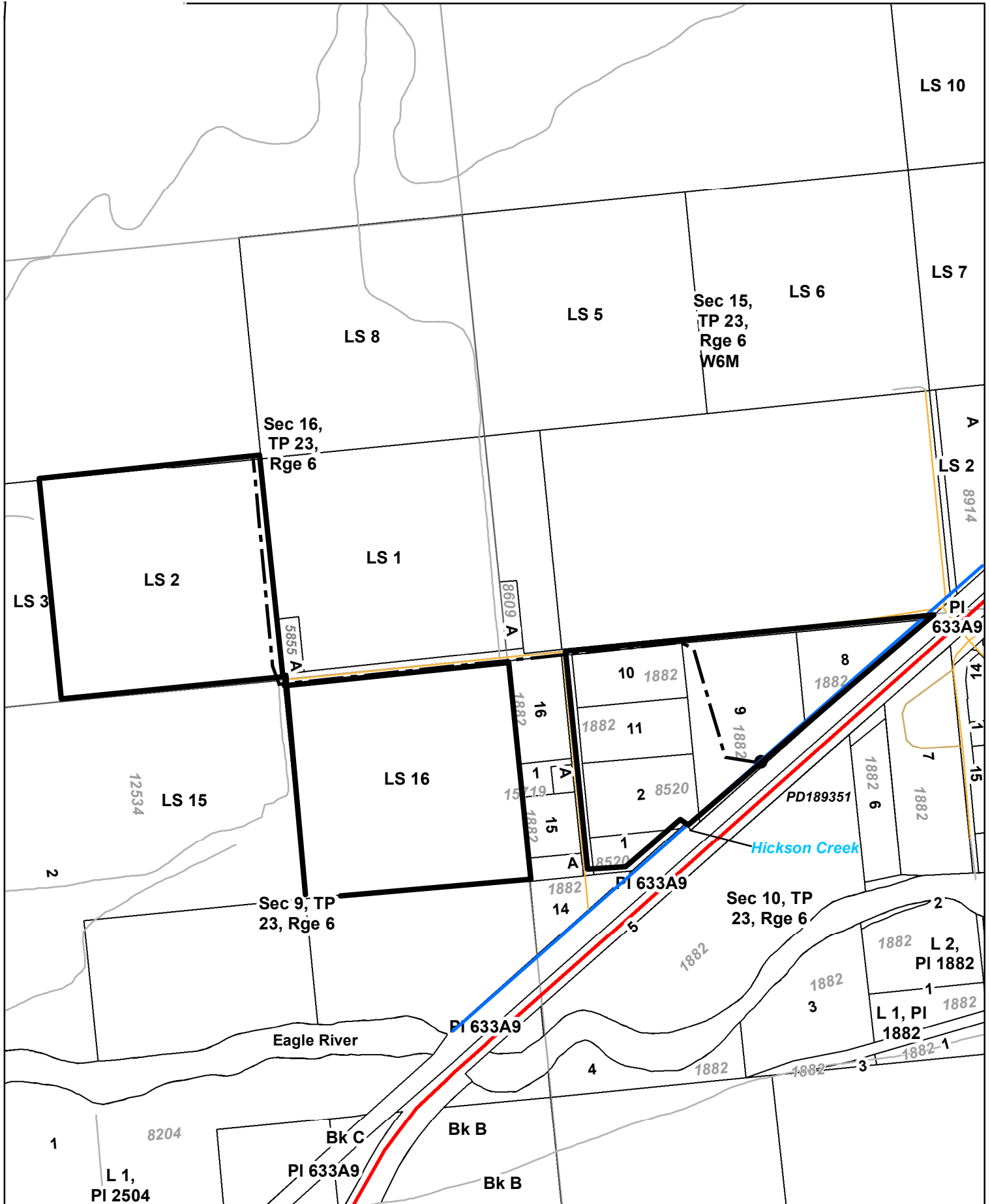
The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Hickson Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is January 8, 2016.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial livestock & animal.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for stock-watering is 10.37 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is January 1 to December 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is:
 - Lot 2 of Plan 8520, and Lots 8 through 11 of Plan 1882, all of Section 10;
 - Legal Subdivision 16 of Section 9, except point included in Plan 5855; and
 - Legal Subdivision 2 of Section 16;all of Township 23 Range 6 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District.
- h) The authorized works are pump-house, pipe, and intake, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The industrial livestock and animal purpose authorized by this licence is for use outside the wetted perimeter of the source in a mobile trough which shall be used throughout the appurtenant lands.
- k) The licensee shall install a flow meter or other measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.
- l) The licensee shall retain flow meter/measurement records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.

- m) This licence is supplementary to licences C116168 and C116171.
- n) This licence is issued under the Water Sustainability Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
