

## Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Nechako River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 10, 1996.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 180,000 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30. The irrigation volume diverted during this period shall be measured, recorded and submitted to an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*, within the calendar year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the Fractional Northeast 1/4 of Section 23 Except Plans A107 and 4507 and the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26 Except Plan 5995 and Epp49684 all in Township 1, Range 4, Coast District of which 60 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, diversion structure, pump, pipe, flow measuring device and sprinklers, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence Number C117279.

k) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
