CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Egan Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 9, 2016.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 1,500 cubic metres a year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to November 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Legal Description: Lot 8, District Lot 438, Range 5, Coast District, Plan 7758.
- h) The authorized works are pipe (partly constructed) and intake (not constructed) which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) All works shall be constructed in accordance with the best management practises outlined in the B.C. Ministry of Environment's "Standards and Best Practices for Instream Works" (2004).
- k) All works shall be constructed, used, and maintained in accordance with the terms and conditions outlined in the B.C. Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure's "Permit to Construct, Use, and Maintain Works within the Right-Of-Way of a Provincial Public Highway" (Permit/File Number 2016-02986).

- 1) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing under the *Water Sustainability Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in a stream.
