
## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to store water as follows:

- a) The source on which the rights are granted is Brigade Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 23, 1907.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is conservation: storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for conservation: storage is 219537 cubic meters per year.
- f) The lake may be filled from the 1st of October to the 1st of June.
- g) The land, upon which this licence is appurtenant is the conservation project of the licensee within the conservation project of the licensee within Sections 6, 31 and 32, Township 17, Range 17, West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District.
- h) The authorized works are a dam which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulation and shall be and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the *Water Sustainability Act* and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence F048848. With partial reallocation from licence C050379.
