## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the mine to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Camp Creek and two unnamed tributaries to Camp Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is January 11, 2016.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are work camps and miscellaneous industrial (dewatering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted from Camp Creek for work camp use is 9.50 cubic metres per day. The stream's total flow may be diverted from the two unnamed tributaries for dewatering purposes.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for camp use is May 1 to October 31. Water may be used for dewatering purposes January 1 to December 31 (the whole year).
- g) The mine upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the mining project of the licensee within Mineral Leases 1031440 and 1031441, Liard Mining Division as shown on the attached plan.
- h) The authorized works are intake, pipe, berm and diversion channel which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.

- k) This licence authorizes the dewatering of approximately 410 metres of two unnamed tributaries to Camp Creek as indicated on the attached plan. Construction of the two diversion channels shall be completed according to the specifications provided by the site-specific water development plan (Rescan 2015) submitted in support of the water licence application.
  
- l) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing from a Water Manager or Assistant Water Manager under the *Water Sustainability Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in a stream or to ensure compliance with the conditions of this licence.
