Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Shuswap Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 1, 2016.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is residential lawn and garden irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for residential lawn and garden irrigation is 3,161 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is all that portion of Legal Subdivision 16 of Section 35 Township 20 Range 10 West of 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District which lies to the east of the east shore of Salmon Arm of Shuswap Lake as shown on a plan of survey of said township dated at Ottawa the 15th day of April, 1911 except Plan 31.
- h) The authorized works are irrigation system, pumphouse, and screened intake. They shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall install a flow meter or other measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- k) The licensee shall retain flow meter/measurement records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.

- l) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
