

## Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Hunt Brook.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 21, 2016.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for power (residential) purpose is 0.06 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is September 1 to June 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which the licence is appurtenant is Lot B, Section 2, Mayne Island, Cowichan District, Plan VIP63440.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, turbine, and transmission line which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The term of this licence is forty (40) years from the date of issuance of this licence.
- k) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to (1) dwelling on Lot B, Section 2, Mayne Island, Cowichan District, Plan VIP63440.
