## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Vance Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 4, 1973.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are livestock and animal stock-watering, and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for livestock and animal stock-watering is 1.1365 m<sup>3</sup> per day, and the maximum quantity which may be used for irrigation is 18,295 m<sup>3</sup> per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for livestock and animal stock-watering is the whole year. The period of the year during which the water may be used for irrigation is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is The North West 1/4 of the South East 1/4 of Section 13 Township 2 Osoyoos Division Yale District, except Plans 31001 and EPP13710.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump, pipe, trough, sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued in substitution of licence C066532, in part.
- k) The licensee shall install a flow meter or other measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.

- l) The licensee shall retain flow meter/measurement records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
  
- m) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
