Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Crescent Spur Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 27, 2016.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Irrigation: Private.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for Irrigation: Private is 20,000 cubic metres per year at a rate not to exceed 0.0034 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Block A, District Lot 8065, Cariboo District and District Lot 8064 Cariboo District.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe, flow meter, and irrigation system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to September 30, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence does not authorize the diversion of water for Irrigation: Private when the water flow of Crescent Spur Creek falls below 0.135 cubic metres per second for the preservation of fish or for maintaining the health of aquatic ecosystems.
- k) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- l) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.

- m) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- n) The licensee must operate the works authorized under clause (h) above in accordance with:
 - (1) procedures ordered by an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*, including any order for the regulation of the diversion, rate of diversion and use of water as may be required for the preservation of fish and the aquatic ecosystems and for the provision of flow for the maintenance of environmental flow needs; and
 - (2) any amendment of the procedures ordered by an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- o) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.



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
