

## Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The source on which the rights are granted is Paul Lake and storage is in Paul Lake.
- b) The storage site and point of diversion and rediversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 6, 2016.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic and stream storage: non-power.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purposes is 2 cubic meters per day, and the maximum quantity which may be used for stream storage: non-power purposes is 730 cubic meters per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for domestic and stream storage: non-power purposes is January 1 to December 31.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Block K District Lot 5855 Kamloops Division Yale Land District.
- h) The authorized works are a screened intake, pipe, pressure tank, pump, and dam which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from

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construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulation and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the *Water Sustainability Act* and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- 1) The construction of the dam has been completed. When so required, the licensee shall arrange to share in the operation, maintenance and any upgrading of the storage works and thereafter shall regularly exercise these rights in a manner approved therein.
- m) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
