CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Bulkley River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 28th, 1995.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic use is 2 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 352, Range 5, Coast District, except Plans 6348 and 9442 and except that part lying North and West of the South boundary of Plan 1155.
- h) The authorized works are a diversion structure, screened intake, pump, and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The rights granted under this licence are subject to a water reservation established by Order in Council No. 418 dated March 3, 1983.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C128794.
