Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Battle Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 7, 1967.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are private irrigation and commercial enterprise.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and used for private irrigation is 185022 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity which may be diverted and used for commercial enterprise is 4.5 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted and used for private irrigation is April 1 to September 30 and for commercial enterprise is the whole year. .
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the South West 1/4 District Lot 2888, Kamloops Division Yale District, except Parcel A (DD 229834F) and Plans KAP65937 and KAP74767, of which 40.469 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, screened intake, pipe, pump, and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other

property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 034195.
