The exercise of the said right of entry, use and occupation is subject to the terms of a certain indenture of agreement made the 27th day of November, 1939, between His Majesty the King therein represented by the Minister of Transport and the Canadian Pacific Railway Company.

An annual rental of one dollar is payable in respect of this permit and the permit may be cancelled if the said rental is not paid punctually.
