Permit under the "Water Act, 1939," authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land.

BRITISH COLUMBIA ELECTRIC COMPANY LIMITED, of Vancouver, B.C.

the holder of a water licence authorizing the storage of water in the Diversion Reservoir as shown on the plan attached to Final Licence No. 12750 is hereby authorized to occupy by flooding.

the following Crown land, namely:—

that portion of land adjacent to District Lot 723 and District Lot 277 (Timber Lease 640D, expired) Renfrew District, more particularly shown on Exhibit "A" and marked "R/W"

having an area of 3.3 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty and stumpage under the "Forest Act" is authorized to destroy the timber on the said land by submerging it.

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$1.00, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation.

This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.

The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.
