Permit under the "Water Act, 1939," authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land

BRITISH COLUMBIA POWER COMMISSION, of Victoria, B.C.,

the holder of a water licence authorizing the storage of water in Whatshan Lake, is hereby authorized to occupy by flooding the following Crown land namely

Lots 8136, 8137, 8138, 8139, 8141, 8142, 8166, (Except Block 9), 8167, 8168, 8169, 8171, 8172, 8173, 8185, (Except Lot 3-4087^I), 8187, 8811, 8543, 8548, 9153, 9155, 9765, 9882, 9883, 9884, 9885, 9886, 9766

the following Crown land, namely:—

and 10028, Special Timber Lease 8266^P, Special Timber Lease 8267^P,

and unsurveyed land, Kootenay Land District, lying below contour 2,140 feet, more particularly shown on Plan #3652H, Water Rights Branch and approximately shown on Exhibit "A" and marked Flooded Area

having an area of 1515.18 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty and stumpage under the "Forest Act" is authorized to destroy the timber on the said lands by submerging it.

Supersedes by new Permit dated #3557 21 Nov 1951 for a larger area

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$151.60, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation.

This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.

The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.
