Permit under the "Water Act," authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land

HAROLD ROTTACKER, of Wells, B. C.

the holder of a water licence authorizing the diversion of water from Oregon Gulch is hereby authorized to occupy by constructing, maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under the said water licence, and any licence which may be issued in substitution thereof

the following Crown land, namely:—

a portion of land lying between Placer Mining Lease 1676 and point of diversion Cariboo Mining Division of Cariboo District being 5,000 feet in length and 15 feet in width, the location of which is shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licence and marked "R/W" having an area of 1.7218 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty, ~~and stumpage and other compensation as provided under Condition 5~~ stumpage and other compensation as provided under Condition 5 is authorized to cut and remove from the said land any timber the removal of which is necessary to permit the construction of the said works.

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$1.00, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation.

This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.

The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.
