Permit under the "Water Act," authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land

ALFRED BRACEWELL, of Tatla Lake, B. C.

the holder of a water licence authorizing the diversion of water from Bracewell Lake is hereby authorized to occupy by constructing, maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under the said water licence, and any licence which may be issued in substitution thereof

the following Crown land, namely:—

a portion of land lying South of District Lot 1194, Range 2, Coast District being 8,200 feet in length and 15 feet in width, the location of which is shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licence and marked "R/W" having an area of 2.82 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty, and stumpage and other compensation as provided under Condition 5 is authorized to cut and remove from the said land any timber the removal of which is necessary to permit the construction of the said works.

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$1.41, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation.

This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.

The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.
