Permit under the "Water Act," authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land

the holder of a water licence authorizing the diversion of water from Emory Creek is hereby authorized to occupy by maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under Final Water Licence No. 14285

the following Crown land, namely:—

a portion of Lot 5, Registered Plan 4955, District Lot 12, Township 6, Range 26, West 6th Meridian being 300 feet in length and 15 feet in width, the location of which is shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licence and marked "R/W" having an area of .1033 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty, ~~and stumpage and other compensation as provided under Condition 5 is~~

stumpage and other compensation as provided under Condition 5 is authorized to cut and remove from the said land any timber the removal of which is necessary to permit the construction of the said works.

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$1.00, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation.

This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.
