Permit under the "Water Act," authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land

MELBOURNE STANLEY MAXWELL, of General Delivery, Vernon, B.C.

the holder of a water licence authorizing the storage of water from Maxwell Creek is hereby authorized to occupy by flooding

the following Crown land, namely:—

that portion of vacant crown land known as the land lying north of District Lot 4020 Osoyoos Division of Yale District more particularly shown on Exhibit "A" and marked "R/W"

having an area of 1 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty, ~~and stumpage under the "Forest Act" is authorized to~~ stumpage and other compensation as provided under Condition 5 is authorized to destroy the timber on the said land by submerging it.

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$1.00, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation.

This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.

The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.
