Permit under the "Water Act," authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land

BEDROCK PLACERS INCORPORATED, of Stanley, B. C.

the holder of a water licence authorizing the diversion of water from Amador Creek is hereby authorized to occupy by constructing, maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under the said water licence, and any licence which may be issued in substitution thereof

the following Crown land, namely:— a portion of Occupied Crown land known as Placer Mining Lease 4457 Cariboo Mining Division being 1,500 feet in length and 15 feet in width and a portion of Unoccupied Crown land known as that land lying between the point of diversion on Amador Creek and Placer Mining Lease 4457 and that land lying between Placer Mining Leases 4457 and 1676, Cariboo Mining Division being 7,600 feet in length and 15 feet in width, the locations of which are shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licence and marked "R/W" having an total area of 3.134 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty, and stumpage under the Forest Act, and to the payment of stumpage and other compensation as provided under Condition 5 is authorized to cut and remove from the said land any timber the removal of which is necessary to permit the construction of the said works.

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$2.00, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation. This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant. The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.
