Permit under the "Water Act" Authorizing the Occupation of Crown Land

BRITISH COLUMBIA POWER COMMISSION, of VICTORIA, B. C.

the holder of a water licence authorizing the storage of water in Buttle Lake, Upper Campbell Lake and Campbell River between Upper Campbell Lake and Campbell Lake is hereby authorized to occupy by flooding

the following Crown land, namely:— all the land between the 730 foot contour and the shoreline of Buttle Lake lying to the south of Block 121 including Block 122 to Block 126 inclusive, Comox Land District. All the land between the 730 foot contour and the shoreline of Buttle Lake including Lots 419, 459, 448 and 449 Nootka Land District, and that part of District Lot 7 Nootka Land District lying between the 730 foot contour and the Elk River more particularly shown on Exhibit "A" and marked "R/W".

having an area of 3,517 acres.

And, subject to the payment of royalty, stumpage, and other compensation as provided under Condition 5,

is authorized to occupy the said lands by submergence in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in Conditional Water Licence No. 22581 and the Exhibit "B" attached thereto.

Before flooding is commenced there shall be carried out such clearing of the reservoir site as may be directed by the Comptroller of Water Rights after consultation with the Parks Division of the British Columbia Forest Service, or as may be set forth under the terms of any Order-in-Council that may issue under the Strathcona Park Act.

There is payable in respect of this permit an annual rental of \$351.70, which is subject to alteration at any time. Failure to pay the annual rental will render this permit subject to cancellation.

This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.

The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.

Conditional Licence No. 22581 PERMIT OVER CROWN LAND No. 4071

**CONDITIONS RELATIVE TO THE RIGHTS GRANTED
UNDER THIS PERMIT**

1. This permit is issued under section 20 of the "Water Act," and the rights hereby granted are subject at all times to the provisions of that Act and all Acts passed in amendment or substitution thereof and to all regulations from time to time made under any such Act.

2. There is reserved to the Crown the right to grant to other persons permits to occupy the land affected by this permit without compensation to the permittee or his successors in title.

3. In the event of any dispute arising at any time between the permittee and any owner of land adjacent to the land affected by this permit with respect to the area or boundaries of the land so affected, the licensee shall at his own expense, when so directed by the Deputy Minister of Lands, have the said land surveyed by a duly qualified surveyor, and shall likewise file with the Department of Lands and Forests at Victoria, B.C., a plan showing the result of the survey.

4. This permit and the rights granted hereunder are subject always to compliance by the permittee with the terms of his water licence, and if the rights granted under the said licence should at any time be suspended or terminated the rights granted under this permit are thereupon likewise suspended or terminated.

5. The amount of stumpage, royalty, and (or) compensation payable to the Crown by the permittee in respect of trees, including merchantable or young growth, cut, removed, damaged, or destroyed by the permittee, shall be the sum or sums fixed by the Forest Service of the Province of British Columbia.
