- (b) The approximate dimensions of the Crown land authorized to be occupied under this permit are 3.500 feet in length and 15 feet in width, having an area of 1.2 acres.
- (c) Subject to the payment of royalty, stumpage, and other compensation as provided under Condition 5, the permittee is authorized to cut and remove from the said land any timber the removal of which is necessary to permit construction and maintenance of the said works.
- (d) The annual rental for this permit is \$ 2.00, which is subject to review and revision at any time at the discretion of the Crown.
- (e) This permit is appurtenant to the land to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.
- (f) The conditions relative to the rights granted under this permit are printed on the back of this form.

CONDITIONS RELATIVE TO THE RIGHTS GRANTED UNDER THIS PERMIT

- 1. This permit is issued under the Water Act, and the rights hereby granted are subject at all times to the provisions of that Act and all Acts bassed in amendment or substitution thereof and to all regulations from time to time made under any such Act.
- 2. There is reserved to the Crown the right to grant to other persons permits to occupy the land affected by this permit without compensation to the permittee or his successors in title
- 3. - 5: The amount of stumpage, royalty, and (or) compensation payable to the Grown by the permittee in respect of trees, including merchanitable or young growth, care, removed, damaged, or destroyed by the permittee, shall be the sum or sume fixed by the freest service of the province of British Columbia.
