

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:


- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Friesen Spring.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 16th October, 1995.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 500 gallons a day.
- (f) The water may be used throughout the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot B, District Lot 819, Kootenay District, Plan NEP22715.
- (h) The works authorized are diversion structure, water flow meter and pipe, which are located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (k) Prior to diversion and use of water under this licence a reservoir with a minimum storage of 2500 imperial gallons must be constructed for the licensee's own use. During periods when the flow of Friesen Spring falls below 3.15 imperial gallons per minute or 4535 imperial gallons per day, diversions under this licence must be from this storage reservoir. Upon completion of this storage reservoir as built drawings must be forwarded to the Land and Water Manager. Works shall be installed to meter and record the rate of flow and quantity of water diverted under this licence. Flow meter records shall be retained by the licensee and be available upon request for inspection by the Regional Water Manager.

**PERMIT OVER CROWN LAND
WATER ACT - Section 26**

You are hereby authorized to enter onto and occupy Crown land for the purpose of constructing works, maintaining and operating works authorized by the above licence. The Crown land so occupied has a length of 2000 feet and a width of 15 feet.

The area authorized to be occupied is 0.69 acre.

This permit is issued subject to all subsisting rights of other persons acquired under other provincial legislation, whether or not the permit holder has actual notice of them.
