
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Coleman Water Works Ltd. is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the West Arm of Kootenay Lake.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached sketch.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 22nd August, 1996.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is waterworks (local authority).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 6,935,000 gallons a year with a peak daily diversion of 43,700 gallons per day.
- (f) The water may be used throughout the whole year.
- (g) This licence is appurtenant the undertaking of the licensee as set out in the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1106 and any amendment thereof or amendment thereto.
- (h) The works authorized are diversion structure, pumps, disinfection facility, reservoir and pipe, which are located approximately as shown on the attached sketch.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.

PERMIT OVER CROWN LAND WATER ACT - Section 26

You are hereby authorized to enter onto and occupy Crown land for the purpose of constructing works, maintaining and operating works authorized by the above licence. The Crown land so occupied has a length of 450 feet and a width of 15 feet.

The area authorized to be occupied is 0.15 acres.

This permit is issued subject to all subsisting rights of other persons acquired under other provincial legislation, whether or not the permit holder has actual notice of them.
