

PERMIT UNDER THE WATER ACT AUTHORIZING THE OCCUPATION OF CROWN LAND

The holder of Final Water Licences 16194 and 16196 whose licences authorize the diversion and use of water from Hat Creek and Oregon Jack Creek respectively, is hereby authorized to occupy Crown land by constructing, maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under the said licence.

- (a) The Crown land which is authorized to be occupied under this permit is a portion of a portion of the North 1/2, Section 20; the South East 1/4 Section 29 and the West 1/2 of Section 28, all of Township 19, Range 26, West of the Sixth Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, and the North 1/2 of the South East 1/4, Section 24; the North East 1/4, Section 24 and the South East 1.4, section 25, all of Township 19, Range 25, west of the Sixth Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, the location of which is shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licence.
- (b) The approximate dimensions of the Crown Land authorized to be occupied under this permit are: ditch 10470 feet (448.1 metres) long by 20 feet (6.1 metres) wide = 4.8 acres (1.94 hectares)
 (A) ditch 80 feet (24.4 metres) long by 40 feet (12.2 metres) wide = 0.07 acre (0.03 hectares)
 (B) ditch 150 feet (45.7 metres) long by 60 feet (18.3 metres) wide = 0.2 acre (0.08 hectares)
 (C) ditch 100 feet (30.5 metres) long by 100 feet (30.5 metres) wide = 0.22 acres (0.09 hectares) ditch and flume 5200 feet (1584.96 metres) long by 15 feet (4.6 metres) wide = 1.79 acres (0.72 hectares)
 - Total land area is 7.08 acres (2.87 hectares).
- (c) Prior to the cutting, destruction of any timber, necessary to permit construction and maintenance of the said works and clearing of the said lands, the permittee shall apply for and obtain a licence to cut timber from the Ministry of Forests, District Manager. The amount of stumpage, royalty and (or) compensation payable to the Crown in respect of trees, including merchantable or young growth, cut, removed, damaged, or destroyed by the permittee, shall be the sum or sums fixed by the Forest Service of the Province of British Columbia.
- (d) This permit is appurtenant to the land, mine or undertaking to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.
- (e) This permit shall become void if the water licence with respect to which the permit is issued should terminate, be abandoned or cancelled, or amended so as to render this permit unnecessary.
- (f) This permit is issued and accepted on the understanding that the permittee shall indemnify and save harmless the Government of the Province of British Columbia for all loss, damage to works, cost or expense suffered by the permittee by reason of the Crown Land or any portion thereof being submerged or damaged by erosion or otherwise affected by flooding.
- (g) The holder of this permit shall not be entitled to compensation if the Crown grants permits to other persons to occupy the land affected by this permit.
- (h) In the event of a dispute at any time with respect to the area or boundaries of the land affected by this permit, the holder shall, at his own expense, have the said land surveyed by a duly authorized surveyor.
- (i) This permit replaces Permit Nos. 4119 and 4121.
