

PERMIT AUTHORIZING THE OCCUPATION OF CROWN LAND UNDER THE WATER ACT

The holder of Conditional Water Licence 119530 is hereby authorized to enter onto and occupy Crown land for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating works authorized by the above licence.

The Crown land authorized to be occupied is a portion of unsurveyed Crown land within the Kyuquot Provincial Forest, Rupert District.

The Crown land so occupied has a width of 4.6 metres (15 feet) and a length of approximately 460 metres (1,500 feet), comprising an area of 0.21 ha (0.51 ac).

Prior to the cutting or destruction (or flooding) of any timber necessary to permit construction and maintenance of the said works (and clearing of the said lands which may be flooded), the permittee shall apply for and obtain a licence to cut timber from the District Manager, Ministry of Forests. The amount of stumpage, royalty and/or compensation payable to the Crown in respect of trees, including merchantable or young growth, cut. removed, damaged, or destroyed by the permittee, shall be the sum or sums fixed by the Forest Service of the Province of British Columbia.

This permit is subject to the provisions of the Navigable Waters Protection Act.

This permit is issued subject to all subsisting rights of other persons acquired under other Provincial legislation, whether or not the permit holder has actual notice of them.
