



**THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA WATER ACT  
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE**

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Cabin Spring.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence has precedence is July 28, 2004.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water that may be diverted is 500 gallons a day.
- f) The period during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the northerly 150 acres of the fractional South ½ of Section 8, Township 61, Cariboo District.
- h) The works authorized to be constructed are diversion structure and pipe, which must be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the works must be completed and the water must be beneficially used on or before December 31, 2007. Thereafter, the licensee must continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized by this licence.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

**PERMIT AUTHORIZING THE OCCUPATION OF CROWN LAND  
UNDER THE WATER ACT**

- (a) The holder of Conditional Water Licence 119807 is hereby authorized to enter onto and occupy Crown land for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating works authorized by the above licence. The Crown land so occupied has a width of 4.6 meters (15 feet) and a length commensurate with the length of the works authorized in the licence.

**This permit is issued subject to all subsisting rights of other persons acquired under other provincial legislation, whether or not the permit holder has actual notice of them.**
