


**PERMIT AUTHORIZING THE OCCUPATION OF CROWN LAND
UNDER THE *WATER ACT***

The holder of Conditional Water Licence 122256 whose licence authorizes the industrial use of 2.273 cubic metres (500 gallons) per day of water from Solitary Creek, is hereby authorized to occupy Crown land by constructing, maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under the said licence.

- (a) The Crown land which is authorized to be occupied under this permit is a portion of unsurveyed crown foreshore or land covered by water being part of the bed of Chancellor Channel, Range 1, Coast District. The location of which is shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licence.
- (b) The approximate dimensions of the Crown land authorized to be occupied under this permit are 120 metres (393.7 feet) in length by 4.572 metres (15 feet) in width for an area of 0.112 hectares (0.276 acres).
- (c) This permit shall become void if the water licence with respect to which the permit is issued should terminate, be abandoned or cancelled, or amended so as to render this permit unnecessary.
- (d) This permit is issued and accepted on the understanding that the permittee shall indemnify and save harmless the Government of the Province of British Columbia for all loss, damage to works, cost or expense suffered by the permittee by reason of the Crown land or any portion thereof being submerged or damaged by erosion or otherwise affected by flooding.
- (e) In the event of a dispute at any time with respect to the area or boundaries of the land affected by this permit, the holder shall, at his own expense, have the said land surveyed by a duly authorized surveyor.
- (f) This permit may be subject to the provisions of the *Navigable Waters Protection Act*.
- (g) This permit is issued subject to all subsisting rights of other persons acquired under other Provincial Legislation, whether or not the permit holder has actual notice of them.
