The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the Chehalis river in New Westminster Water District appears suitable for the development of water power but the information available in that connection is not sufficient to enable any intending applicant to properly make application under the Water Act;

THAT it appears advisable in order to enable the suitability of the said Chehalis river to be investigated to reserve all the unrecorded water of the said river and its tributaries;

AND TO RECOMMEND:

THAT pursuant to the provisions of section 290 of the Water Act, being chapter 271 of the revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1924, all the unrecorded water of Chehalis river and its tributaries in New Westminster Water District be reserved for power purpose and be reserved from being taken or used or acquired under the provisions of the said Water Act.
